## Welding Codes

Speaker: Pat Dorris, *Welder Training and Testing Institute*

There are many codes and specifications that relate to welding. In order to properly understand these codes, an inspector must be familiar with the individual requirements and acceptance standards. This talk will cover the three most commonly referenced welding codes: AWS D1.1, ASME IX, and API 1104. Similarities and differences of procedure and welder qualifications and visual inspection requirements will be covered within the presentation.

Pat Dorris is the Director at Welder Training and Testing Institute. Pat has been with WTTI since 1977; and oversees the programs offered at the facility, as well as develops the custom training programs offered to fabricators, mechanical contractors, utility companies, etc.

Pat had previously worked for General Dynamics/Electric Boat Division in Groton, Connecticut. Pat is an AWS Certified Welding Inspector and a Level III NDT Inspector.
